Position Overview:

Aquatics Staff are responsible for providing safe, engaging, and high-quality aquatics programming at Camp Barstow. Staff members teach aquatics-based merit badges and skills, supervise waterfront and pool activities, and serve as positive role models for Scouts. Aquatics Staff help ensure that all participants have a fun, educational, and safe experience while upholding the values of Scouting America.

Responsibilities:

- Teach aquatics-based merit badges and lessons
- Present in front of group sizes of 2-24 youth and transfer knowledge
- Turn in advancement paperwork to supervisor in a timely manner
- Assist with the set-up, maintenance, and take down of program areas
- Provide First Aid as needed
- Model the Scout Oath and Law in daily interactions
- Maintain a clean, organized, inspected, neat, and safe work area
- Perform additional duties assigned by Camp Barstow leadership
- Abide by policies and procedures outlined in the Camp Barstow staff handbook

Critical Elements of the Position:

- Must be 16 years of age or older.
- Follows all health and safety guidelines made by the County, State, USA, and Scouting America.
- CPR/First Aid/AED Certified or willingness to get certified.
- Red Cross Lifeguard Certified or willingness to get certified.
- Extensive walking and moderate lifting required.

Compensation:

- Pay Range: \$200-\$350/week d.o.e.
- Room & Board while camp in session
