

## Dining Hall Steward Staff

Reports To: Dining Hall Steward Lead, Food Service Director & Camp Director

### Position Overview

Dining Hall Steward Staff are responsible for supporting the daily operations of the Camp Barstow dining hall by maintaining a clean, organized, and welcoming environment for campers and staff. Stewards play a vital role in food service support, sanitation, and hospitality while modeling the values of Scouting America. This position helps ensure meals are served efficiently, safely, and in accordance with health and safety standards.

### Responsibilities

- Assist with meal service, including setup, service support, and cleanup for all scheduled meals
- Maintain cleanliness and sanitation of the dining hall, kitchen support areas, and serving lines
- Wash dishes, cookware, utensils, and food service equipment as assigned
- Set up and break down dining hall seating, serving stations, and program elements
- Monitor trash, recycling, and compost areas and ensure proper disposal procedures are followed
- Follow all food safety, sanitation, and hygiene guidelines
- Provide courteous and helpful customer service to Scouts, leaders, and staff
- Model the Scout Oath and Law in daily interactions
- Maintain a clean, organized, inspected, neat, and safe work environment
- Assist with special meals, camp-wide events, and food deliveries as needed
- Perform additional duties as assigned by Camp Barstow leadership
- Abide by policies and procedures outlined in the Camp Barstow Staff Handbook

### Critical Elements of the Position

- Must be 15 years of age or older
- Ability to work in a fast-paced environment and follow instructions
- Ability to stand for extended periods and perform moderate lifting
- Willingness to work early mornings, evenings, and weekends as scheduled
- Commitment to following all health and safety guidelines set by County, State, Federal, and Scouting America

- Food safety or ServSafe certification preferred (or willingness to obtain if required)
