  - ▶ A TROOP GUIDE WILL ESCORT YOUR SCOUTS THROUGHOUT THE PROCESS STARTING WITH THE CAMPSITE.
  - ▶ ALL THE ADMINISTRATIVE CHECK-IN ITEMS HAPPEN IN THE DINING HALL & PAVILION.
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# IN THE DINING HALL


- ▶ YOUR TROOP WILL WAIT OUTSIDE PLAYING GAMES ETC IN THE PAVILION WHILE THE SM AND SPL GO IN THE DINING HALL.
  - ▶ THE FIRST TABLE IS REGISTRATION WHERE YOU WILL SETTLE UP AND CONFIRM BUNDLE SCHEDULES.
  - ▶ THE NEXT TABLE IS WITH OUR DINING HALL MANAGER TO BE BRIEFED ON OPERATIONS AND ASSIGNED TABLES.
  - ▶ WHEN YOUR SCOUTS ARE INVITED INSIDE THEY WILL GO THROUGH THE MEDICAL SCREENING.
  - ▶ THE FINAL STATION IS PICKING UP SWAG ITEMS.
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# REST OF THE DAY


- ▶ TROOPS NEEDING SWIM CHECKS WILL HEAD TO THE WATERFRONT.
  - ▶ IF YOUR TROOP HAS A SWIM CHECK FORM OUR AQUATICS DIRECTOR REQUESTS A COPY OF THE LIFEGUARD CERTIFICATION BE ATTACHED.
  - ▶ ONCE YOU HAVE COMPLETED ALL THE STATIONS YOUR SCOUTS ARE DONE UNTIL SUPPER.
  - ▶ 7 PM THERE IS AN IMPORTANT SCOUT LEADER MEETING (2 REPRESENTATIVES) TO COVER MANY TOPICS.
  - ▶ 8:30 OPENING CAMPFIRE
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# CAMPSITE NOTES

- ▶ THERE IS POWER IN ALL THE ADIRONDACKS AND SHELTER.
  - ▶ EVERYONE SHOULD BRING A BOX FAN – MOSQUITO NETS ARE OPTIONAL, SHEETS FOR THE MATTRESSES
  - ▶ LARGE ADIRONDACKS ARE FOR YOUTH ONLY. IF YOU ARE SHARING A CAMPSITE YOU MAY HAVE MIXED SCOUTS DEPENDING ON THE SIZE OF YOUR TROOP
  - ▶ WHILE ALL CAMPSITES EXCEPT #5 SALUDA AND #10 WATEREE HAVE ADULT ADIRONDACKS YOU MAY WANT TO BRING A PERSONAL TENT. IT IS DIFFICULT TO ACCOMMODATE MEN/WOMEN IN THE ADULT ADIRONDACK – WE LET THE TROOP FIGURE OUT ADULT SLEEPING ARRANGEMENTS
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# GENERAL NOTES GOOD TO KNOW


- ▶ WE ARE NOT GIVING OUT FREE WATER BOTTLES OR STRING BAGS THIS YEAR. EACH SCOUT WILL GET A BUFF FACE COVERING
  - ▶ DESIGNATE A LEADER IN YOUR TROOP TO KEEP AND DISPENSE ANY PRESCRIPTION MEDICINE
  - ▶ IT IS YOUR CHOICE WHETHER SCOUTS BRING ELECTRONIC DEVICES BUT THE CAMP IS NOT RESPONSIBLE IF ANYTHING IS LOST OR STOLEN
  - ▶ FEEL FREE TO BRING PERSONAL FISHING EQUIPMENT. SC DOES REQUIRE A FISHING LICENSE FOR THOSE 16+
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- ▶ MAKE SURE IF YOU HAVE ANY SCOUTS WITH FOOD ALLERGIES THAT YOU COMPLETE THE GOOGLE FORM. [LINK HERE](#)

  - ▶ OTHER BUNDLES REQUIRE SCOUTS TO BRING MATERIALS
    - NATURALIST: BRING BINOCULARS FOR BIRD STUDY
    - OUTDOORSMAN: RAINGEAR, POCKET KNIFE, FLASHLIGHT, WATER BOTTLE, BACKPACK, SMALL TENT, SLEEPING BAG, BOWL & SPOON
    - ADVENTURER: TENT OR HAMMOCK, SLEEPING BAG (NEED TO BE PASS THE SWIMMING TEST)
    - RANGER: POCKET KNIFE, FLASHLIGHT, WATER BOTTLE, BACKPACK, SLEEPING BAG, BOWL & SPOON
  - ▶ WE ARE TRYING TO WORK OUT SOME HELP WITH TRANSPORTATION.
